4. Tax Assessor/Collector's report, including:

 - (b) Delinquent Tax Report;
5. Bookkeeper's report, including authorize payment of the District's bills;

 - (a) discuss detention pond maintenance;
 - (b) status of nutria issue at Lawrence Place Detention Channel;
7. Drainage Maintenance Report, including replacement of MUD signage;
8. Ratify approval of insurance renewal proposal;
9. Adopt Resolution Adopting and Determining Prevailing Wage Rates for Construction Projects;
10. Attorney's Report; and
11. Such other matters as may come before the Board.
